

How to change your child's stop for once off occasions

Parents now have the ability in RollCall to adjust their child's stop for once off occasions for the current/next day.

Please see below instructions:

- 1. Log into your parent Roll Call account by going to http://bmg.rollcall.com.au/parent
- 2. Select the 'Buses' tab as shown in example 1
- 3. Click on the blue "Make a Change" button, then change to the date required (either today or tomorrow) (see example 1).
- 4. Now select the 'View Buses' tab (shown in example 2) to display the 'change' option.
- 5. Click the green "Change" button next to either AM or PM, and select the new stop from the drop down list (see example 2).
- 6. Select 'confirm' once you have selected the correct stop.
- 7. You are then required to select the green "Confirm" button to save your change.
